TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR COUNSEL OF RECORD:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on May 19, 2009 at 1:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard in Courtroom 3 of the above-captioned Court, located at 1301 Clay Street, Oakland, California, 94612, Defendants Shell Oil Company, Exxon Mobil Corporation, Chevron Corporation, Chevron U.S.A. Inc., ConocoPhillips Company, BP America Inc., and BP Products North America Inc. ("Oil Company Defendants" or "Defendants") will and hereby do move to dismiss the Complaint pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6).
