RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 09-7-14-C
Opposition to Removal of Objects of Cultural Patrimony from the Bottomlands of Lake Huron

WHEREAS: The Bay Mills Indian Community is a federally recognized

Indian Tribe, with a government organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 (25 U.S.C. sec. 461, et

seq., and

WHEREAS: The General Tribal Council is empowered by Article VI,

Section 1(f) of the Bay Mills Indian Community Constitution

to protect the cultural resources of the Community, and

WHEREAS: The General Tribal Council by Resolution adopted April 13,

1970, delegated to the Executive Council the power to

exercise its regulatory authority, and

WHEREAS: Federal law, including the American Antiquities Act, 16

U.S.C. sec. 432, et seq., the Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act, 25 U.S.C. sec. 3001, et seq., and the National Historic Preservation Act, 16 U.S.C. sec. 471, et seq., recognize the importance of objects of

cultural patrimony to the Tribes of this country, and

WHEREAS: The announced removal of materials found on the

bottomland of Lake Huron near Presque Isle, Michigan, by researchers from the University of Michigan is contrary to the expressed federal policy and prevents the Bay Mills Indian Community from protecting its ancestors and their artifacts from being inappropriately studied, displayed and

handled.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Council hereby

formally expresses its opposition to the removal of any remains and artifacts from the Lake Huron bottomlands by persons associated with the University of Michigan or any

other entity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any objects which are removed from the Lake Huron bottomlands be repatriated to the Bay Mills

Indian Community, as required by sec. 7 of the Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act, 25

U.S.C. sec. 3005.
