## PLAINTIFF-INTERVENOR CAYUGA NATION'S MOTION FOR A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, as well as Local Rules 65(a)(1), (2) and 65(b), Plaintiff-Intervenor the Cayuga Indian Nation of New York ("Cayuga Nation") seeks a temporary restraining order and preliminary injunction against the Defendants, enjoining and restraining them from implementing, administering, or enforcing N.Y. Tax Law §§ 471(1), (2), (5), N.Y. Tax Law § 471-e, and 20 N.Y.C.R.R. § 74.6 during the pendency of this action. Unless restrained as requested herein, the Defendants' enforcement of the above-

referenced Tax Laws and regulations - which become effective on September 1, 2010 - will result in an irreparable deprivation of the Cayuga Nation's fundamental rights.

This motion is supported by the Cayuga Nation's Proposed Intervenor Complaint, filed August 25, 2010, the Declaration of Lee Alcott, Esq., dated August 25, 2010, and the Cayuga Nation's Memorandum of Law dated August 25, 2010.
