26	2. Plaintiff Matthew Lewis d/b/a U S Fi	nish (hereinafter "Plaintiff") filed the state

1		court action against the Tulalip Housing Limited Partnership #3, a Washington
2		Limited Partnership; Mike Alva and Patti Gobin; and Chuck James and Jane Doe
3		James (collectively "Defendants"); and the Fund.
4	3.	The Complaint was served on the Fund's registered agent on July 11, 2011. The
5		Fund filed its Notice of Appearance on July 27, 2011. A true and correct copy of
6		the Fund's Notice of Appearance is attached hereto as Exhibit 2.
7	4.	On July 29, 2011, the Fund submitted its Rule 12(b)(2) and 12(b)(6) Motions to
8		Dismiss. A true and correct copy of the Fund's Motions to Dismiss,
9		Memorandum in Support, and Declaration of Ronald M. Diner are attached as
10		Exhibit 3.
11	5.	Plaintiff submitted his Opposition to the Fund's Motions to Dismiss on August 8,
12		2011. A true and correct copy of Plaintiff's Opposition to the Fund's Motions to
13		Dismiss and Declaration of George W. Akers are attached as Exhibit 4.
14	6.	On August 10, 2011, the Snohomish County Superior Court denied the Fund's
15		Rule 12(b)(2) Motion to Dismiss and struck the Fund's Rule 12(b)(6) Motion to
16		Dismiss without prejudice so that it could be resubmitted to the Court. A true and
17		correct copy of the Court's Order is attached as Exhibit 5.
18	7.	On August 10, 2011, Plaintiff's counsel submitted a Notice of Unavailability,
19		stating that he would be unavailable until October 3, 2011. A true and correct
20		copy of the Notice of Unavailability is attached as Exhibit 6.
21	8.	The Fund submitted its Answer and Affirmative Defenses on August 19, 2011. A
22		true and correct copy of the Fund's Answer and Affirmative Defenses is attached
23		hereto as Exhibit 7.
24	9.	On August 23, 2011, Defendants, but not the Fund, submitted a Motion to
25		Dismiss for lack of personal jurisdiction and failure to join a necessary and
26		indispensable party. A true and correct copy of the Calendar Notice; Motion to

1		Dismiss; and the Declarations of Michael Alva, Michael Taylor, Charles James,
2		and Melvin Sheldon are attached as Exhibit 8.
3	10.	On August 29, 2011, Plaintiff submitted its Opposition to Defendants' Motion to
4		Dismiss. A true and correct copy of the Opposition and the Declaration of
5		George W. Akers are attached as Exhibit 9. Defendants submitted their Reply to
5		Plaintiff's Opposition to their Motion to Dismiss on August 30, 2011. A true and
7		correct copy of Defendants' Reply is attached as Exhibit 10.
8	11.	On August 31, 2011, the state court orally dismissed all the defendants from the
)		state court action other than the Fund (the Fund was not included in Defendants'
10		Motion to Dismiss). The Court's Order dismissing Defendants was signed and
11		entered on September 16, 2011. A true and correct copy of the September 16,
12		2011 Order is attached as Exhibit 11. The Fund is now the only remaining
i3		defendant in state court action.
14	12.	Also on August 31, 2011, the Fund submitted its First Amended Answer and
15		Affirmative Defenses. A true and correct copy of the Fund's First Amended
16		Answer and Affirmative Defenses is attached hereto as Exhibit 12.
17	13.	On September 2, 2011, the Fund submitted a Motion to Dismiss pursuant to CR
18		12(b)(1) for lack of personal jurisdiction and pursuant to CR 12(b)(7) for failure
19		to join a necessary and indispensable party. A true and correct copy of the Fund's
20		Motion to Dismiss is attached as <u>Exhibit 13</u> .
21	14.	On September 6, 2011, Plaintiff submitted a Motion for Order Shortening Time
22 -		and a Declaration of Jonathan R. Moore in support. The Snohomish County
23		Superior Court entered an Order Shortening Time on September 7, 2011. A true
24		and correct copy of the Motion, Declaration, and Order Shortening Time are
25		attached as Exhibit 14.
26	15.	Also on September 6, 2011, Plaintiff submitted a Motion to Continue the deadline

for Plaintiff's response to the Fund's Motion to Dismiss and the hearing on the Motion to Dismiss, as well as the Declaration of Jonathan R. Moore in support. The Court granted the Motion to Continue on September 7, 2011. A true and correct copy of the Motion, Declaration, and Order to Continue are attached as Exhibit 15. The new deadline for Plaintiff's response to the Fund's Motion to Dismiss was scheduled for September 25, 2011; the new hearing date was scheduled for October 14, 2011; and the discovery deadlines were stayed five weeks. Plaintiff has a pending Request for Production of Documents to the Fund, which response to the Request for Production of Documents has been extended to October 18, 2011 by the Court's Order. A true and correct copy of the new Calendar Note for the new hearing date is attached as Exhibit 16.

- 16. This Court has jurisdiction over this action pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1332 on diversity of citizenship grounds and so this action may be removed to this Court by the Fund. Removal is pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §1441 and §1446 in that it is a civil action where the matter in controversy exceeds the sum or value of \$75,000 and is between citizens of different states.
- 17. The Complaint alleged that Plaintiff Matthew Lewis is a Snohomish County, Washington resident doing business as US Finish. See, Ex. 1, ¶1.1. Therefore, Plaintiff is a citizen of the state of Washington. The Fund is an active Delaware limited liability company with its principal place of business located in St. Petersburg, Florida. See, Ex. 12, ¶3. Thus, the Fund is a citizen of the state of Delaware and the state of Florida. Plaintiff seeks an award for damages totaling \$1,742,830.89. See, Ex. 1, ¶4.4, 5.3. Complete diversity of citizenship exists between Plaintiff and Defendant. Information on complete diversity of citizenship of the remaining parties did not become readily ascertainable until, at the earliest, August 31, 2011 when the Snohomish County Superior Court orally

1	ruled that it was dismissing the other Defendants, or on September 16, 2011 when
2	the Snohomish County Superior Court signed the Order dismissing the other
3	defendants. See, Ex. 11; see also, Caterpillar Inc. v. Lewis, 519 U.S. 61, 69, 117
4	S. Ct. 467 (1996) ("In a case not originally removable, a defendant who receives a
5	pleading or other paper indicating the post commencement satisfaction of federal
6	jurisdictional requirements-for example, by reason of the dismissal of a
7	nondiverse party-may remove the case to federal court within 30 days of receiving
8	such information"). Therefore, removal is appropriate pursuant to 28 U.S.C.
9	§§1332, 1441, and 1446.
10	18. A true and correct copy of this Notice of Removal is being filed this date with the
11	Clerk of the Superior Court, Snohomish County, Washington.
