**Position:** Chief Legislative Counsel, Legislative Legal Department (Full Time – Contractual)

**Summary:** The Chief Legislative Counsel shall be responsible for providing consideration to and service concerning legislative matters brought before the Tribal Council or Legislative Branch. As Administrator of the Department, Counsel will coordinate the efforts necessary for the preparation of legislative measures, written opinions, research, and competent representation of the Tribe.

- J. D. Degree from an ABA accredited law school; and
- a minimum of five (5) years management experience with a law practice or legal department; and
- an established and successful legislative legal background in Indian Law as demonstrated by working for a federally recognized Tribe; and
- previous litigation experience in a tribal court system; and
- a license to practice law (shall obtain Michigan Bar within one year of employment, if applicable).
