INTERIM ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the Court by request of Petitioner, whereby the Comanche Nation, having adopted Tribal Council Resolutions No. 3-12 and No. 4-12 on May 19, 2012, expressly authorizing this Court to resolve the matter of disputed recalls of six Business Committee members, now asks this Court to assist in alleviating its frozen financial accounts at IBC Bank (pursuant to an interpleader action Case No. CIV 12-627-C, WDOK) and prevent a shutdown of the tribal government. The Court, being fully advised, hereby **FINDS:**

1. This Court has jurisdiction pursuant to the terms of Section 1(b) of *Comanche Nation's Tribal Court Civil Jurisdiction Ordinance of 2011* (adopted by Comanche Nation Resolution No. 36-11 and approved by BIA Southern Plains Regional Office on June 10, 2011) as the Comanche Nation is the Petitioner, and in accordance with 25 C.F.R. § 11.118(b) (2011), whereby the Comanche Tribal Council by its Resolution No. 3-12 (adopted May 19, 2012) expressly authorizes this Court to address this Matter;
2. The freezing of Comanche Nation financial accounts by IBC Bank creates a foreseeable and impending shut-down of fundamental and vital

government services, including the lay-off of dozens of tribal government employees;

3. The intervening election of Wallace Coffey as Comanche Nation Chairman on June 1, 2012, caused the ~~lawful~~ ^{de Facto} removal of Johnny Wauqua from the office of Chairman in accordance with the Comanche Nation Constitution; and

4. Until the matters raised by the Petition can be fully adjudicated, it is prudent for the Court to issue an interim order to alleviate unnecessary

suffering and economic distress of the Comanche Nation and its members. ^{as a consequence of this ancillary issue necessitating an emergency Order.}

THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:

A. Until their respective successors are duly elected, the Comanche Business Committee is, and shall be, lawfully composed as follows:

- Wallace Coffey, Chairman
- Edward Eschiti, Vice Chairman
- Robert Tippeconnie, Secretary/Treasurer
- Ronald Red Elk, Committeeman #1
- Yonevea Terry, Committeeman #2
- Darrell Kosechequetah, Committeeman #3
- Vacant, Committeeman #4

B. Until his successor is duly hired, the Comanche Nation Tribal Administrator is, and shall be, Robert Komacheet.
