STATE BAR OF SOUTH DAKOTA

Urges federal, state, territorial, tribal and local governments to support efforts to address the decline in the number of lawyers practicing in rural areas and to address access to justice issues for residents in rural America.

TORT TRIAL AND INSURANCE PRACTICE SECTION

Recognizes the fundamental importance of the right to trial by jury and opposes contractually required pre-dispute waivers of the right to trial by jury except where specifically authorized by law.

SECTION OF INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES COMMISSION ON DOMESTIC AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE NATIONAL NATIVE AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION

Urges Congress to strengthen tribal jurisdiction to address crimes of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, and sex trafficking committed on tribal lands in the reauthorization of the Violence Against Women Act.
