deer herd, deer in rock creek park, Rock Creek Park Officials said the deer herd has grown since the 1960s, when just four white-tailed deer were spotted in the park. They said the four-square-mile park now has 80 deer per square mile.

Park officials will continue monitoring the deer population and using fences to protect plants. However, they will also use sharpshooters and a capture-and-euthanize program. Sharpshooting will be done mainly at night during late fall and winter.




