It has recently come to the attention of counsel for the Federal Defendants that plaintiff Alturas Indian Rancheria appears to be a member of the class certified by the District Court in *Ramah Navajo Chapter v. Jewell*, Case No. 1:90-cv-957-LH-KBM (D.N.M.), which includes those Indian tribes and organizations who have contracted with the Secretary of the Interior under the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act ("ISDEAA"). This case is the same case as *Salazar v. Ramah Navajo Chapter*, 132 S. Ct. 2181 (2012), cited in the parties' briefs, which concerns payment of contract support costs pursuant to the ISDA and the Contract Disputes Act. Counsel for the class in that case is Michael P. Gross of Santa Fe, NM.

1 Accordingly, unless the Tribe can show that it has opted out of the *Ramah* class, the Tribe should
2 not be allowed to pursue its claim for contract support costs under its ISDEAA contracts here.
