NATURE OF WORK:

Supervises the prosecution of cases filed in Tribal Court within the jurisdiction of the Prosecutor's Office, which includes all violations of Tribal laws and ordinances that are within the original or concurrent jurisdiction of the Tribal Court. Supervision is exercised over all professional and administrative support staff members of the Prosecutor's Office. The Prosecutor's Office establishes and conducts youth and community diversion programs and provides community education programs dealing with Tribal law enforcement.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Juris Doctorate and five (5) years of experience as a practicing Attorney including two (2) years of substantial involvement in the management process and policy making function of a law office and one (1) year experience as a Prosecutor or an equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the job such as those listed above.

AND

- Working knowledge of and experience in Indian Law required.
- Bilingual in English/Spanish preferred, but not required.

LICENSING REQUIREMENTS:

- Must possess and maintain a valid Arizona Driver's license.
- Current member of the Arizona or Federal State Bar.
- Tribal Court certification.

BACKGROUND CHECK:

- Must provide at least three (3) business related reference letters.
- Must pass a background check and drug test.
- Funding and sensitivity of position will determine fingerprinting requirement.

Pascua Yaqui Preference Acts of 2000: Members of the tribe shall be given absolute preference with respect to hiring and promotions for positions with the Pascua Yaqui Tribe. For persons who meet the above minimum required qualifications preferential treatment shall be based on the following criteria and shall be given in the following: 1) enrolled member of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe 2) spouses of enrolled members of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe 3) enrolled member of other recognized tribes 4) other applicants.
