3. Respondent shall appear at the offices of the Internal Revenue Service, 51 SW 1st

Avenue, Room 1014, Miami, FL 33130 at 9:00 a.m. on September 9, 2014 or at other

such day and time as directed by Revenue Agent James Furnas or other officer of the

Internal Revenue Service to give testimony as required and called for by the summons.

4. The Clerk shall **CLOSE** this case for administrative purposes only. Either party may

move to reopen the case for good cause shown, including if Respondent fails to timely

produce the documents or give testimony as required by this Order. Any pending

motions are **DENIED AS MOOT**.
