fully advised finds that Plaintiff's Complaint against the Quinault Indian Nation is barred by the doctrine of Tribal sovereign immunity.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED as follows:

- 1. Defendant Quinault Indian Nation's Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED.
- 2. Plaintiffs' Complaint is dismissed without prejudice with leave to amend within thirty (30) days.
