I am the presiding judge for the Pueblo of Pojoaque Tribal Court. I write to support the proposed regulations to improve Indian Child Welfare Act implementation by State courts and child welfare agencies.

The clarity and certainty provided in these regulations will help preserve Indian families and promote permanency for Indian children. These regulations will ensure that tribes become involved as early as possible in state child welfare cases so that these case are transferred to tribal courts with little delay. It is also important that state courts understand that the "Existing Indian Family Exception" is not a valid consideration under ICWA.
