

ORDER

On July 21, 2014, plaintiffs filed under seal a motion for sanctions ("Sanctions Motion") against former defendant, Jeff Davis, as Presiding Judge of the Seventh Judicial Circuit of the State of South Dakota. (Docket 114). The parties and a number of interested parties engaged in discovery and briefing on the issues which arose in relation to the Sanctions Motion. On April 1, 2016, plaintiffs and Judge Davis filed under seal a joint stipulation to dismiss plaintiffs' Sanctions Motion. (Docket 237).

Based on the stipulation and good cause appearing, it is

ORDERED that the stipulation (Docket 237) is accepted and the relief requested is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiffs' motion for sanctions (Docket 114) is dismissed with prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiffs will be compensated in the amount of \$50,000 as reasonable attorneys' fees associated with the motion for sanctions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall unseal and make available to the public all pleadings and orders currently sealed or restricted to case participants, which documents are associated with plaintiffs' motion for sanctions.
