I. INTRODUCTION

1. Defendants are violating or will violate the Nooksack Constitution and laws. Defendants are attempting or will attempt to conduct an illegal disenrollment Referendum Election, and to illegally manipulate the Nooksack Tribal Council Primary Election and General Election mandated by the Nooksack Constitution and Tribal Election Ordinance.

II. JURISDICTION

2. Plaintiffs, enrolled members of the Nooksack Indian Tribe, bring this action against Defendants, who are officers, employees, or agents of the Tribe, acting in their official

1 and/or personal capacities.

2 3. Because Plaintiffs allege that Defendants, in their official capacities, are acting
3 unconstitutionally and are threatening to continue to act unconstitutionally, and because
4 Plaintiffs seek nonmonetary declaratory and injunctive relief, the Court has jurisdiction pursuant
5 to *Lomeli v. Kelly*, No. 2013-CI-APL-002, at 14 (Nooksack Ct. App. Jan. 15, 2013).

6 4. Because Plaintiffs allege that Defendants, in their personal capacities, have acted
7 “outside the scope of [their] authority” in that their actions have been, or will be, “done in any
8 way other than by the proper procedures” required by Nooksack law, this Court has jurisdiction.
9 *Cline v. Cunanan*, No. NOO-CIV-02/08-5 (Nooksack Ct. App. Jan. 12, 2009).

10 5. Because this is a “civil matter[] concerning members of the Nooksack Indian
11 Tribe” and a “matter[] concerning the . . . functions of the tribal government,” this Court may
12 assert subject matter jurisdiction over this action. *Belmont v. Kelly*, No. 2013-CI-CL-007, Order
13 Denying Defendants’ Motion for Preliminary Injunction (Nooksack Tribal Ct. Jan. 26, 2016), at
14 9 (quoting Nooksack Constitution, Art. VI § (A)(3)); *see also* *Campion v. Swanaset*, 4 NICS
15 App. 159 (Nooksack Ct. App. 1996).

16 III. PARTIES

17 6. Defendants are members of the Nooksack Tribal Council (“Tribal Councilperson
18 Defendants”), Election Superintendent Katrice Romero, and unknown or yet to be appointed
19 Nooksack officials¹ who are each sued in their respective official and personal capacities
20 (collectively “Defendants”).

23 ¹ “It is permissible to use Doe defendant designations in a complaint to refer to defendants whose names are
24 unknown to plaintiff.” *Robinett v. Correctional Training Facility*, 2010 WL 2867696, at *4 (N.D. Cal. Jul. 20,
2010). In such circumstances, once the unknown defendants are known, the Court must allow them to be amended
into the Complaint. *Gillespie v. Civiletti*, 629 F.2d 637, 642 (9th Cir. 1980).

7. Plaintiffs are enrolled members of the Nooksack Indian Tribe. Plaintiffs include those persons set forth on the May 5, 2013, Galanda Broadman representation list on file with this Court in *Lomeli v. Kelly* (“Nooksack 306” Plaintiffs), as well as additional Plaintiffs not targeted for disenrollment who demand that their government act constitutionally, regardless of the any disenrollment controversy.

IV. FACTS

8. Since 2013, the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs have been formally proposed for disenrollment by Tribal Councilperson Defendants. Disenrollment proceedings against these Plaintiffs are currently stayed or enjoined by an Order of this Court.

9. On December 18, 2015, Tribal Councilperson Defendants amended Title 62, the Nooksack Tribal Election Ordinance (“Election Ordinance”) to gerrymander the February 20, 2016 Primary Election and March 19, 2016 General Election for Defendants Rick D. George, Agripina Smith, Katherine Canete and Agripina “Lona” Johnson’s open Tribal Council seats.

10. Article III, Sections 3 and 4 of the Nooksack Constitution requires that elections for Defendants Rick D. George, Agripina Smith, Katherine Canete and Agripina “Lona” Johnson’s open Tribal Council seats be called within 90 days prior to the expiration of the terms of those Defendants’ Tribal Council offices. Nooksack Tribal Code §§ 62.02.020-030 requires that those open Tribal Council seats be subject to a Primary Election on February 20, 2016 and General Election on March 19, 2016.

11. Defendants have failed to call or commence the election for Defendants Rick D. George, Agripina Smith, Katherine Canete and Agripina “Lona” Johnson’s open Tribal Council seats within 90 days prior to the expiration of the terms of those Defendants’ Tribal Council offices.

1 12. On January 5, 2016, Tribal Councilperson Defendants announced at a Nooksack
2 Community Council meeting that they had “cancelled” the February 20, 2016 Primary Election
3 and March 19, 2016 General Election for Defendants Rick D. George, Agripina Smith, Katherine
4 Canete and Agripina “Lona” Johnson’s open seats and “postponed” any election for those seats
5 until after disenrollment proceedings against the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs finally conclude.

6 13. On January 26, 2016, former Nooksack Tribal Court Chief Judge Susan
7 Alexander denied Tribal Councilperson Defendants’ motion for preliminary injunction in
8 *Belmont v. Kelly*, No. 2013-CI-CL-007, which sought to prevent the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs and
9 other proposed disenrollees from voting in the February 20, 2016 Primary Election and March
10 19, 2016 General Election. Order Denying Defendants’ Motion for Preliminary Injunction,
11 *supra*, at 21. Noting that Defendants “have already violated several constitutional and statutory
12 mandates regarding the timing of events leading up to the elections,” the Trial Court held:

13 Unequivocally, Plaintiffs are enrolled members of the Nooksack Indian Tribe and,
14 pursuant to Nooksack Constitution, Article VI, Section 1, “[a]ll enrolled members
15 of the Nooksack Indian Tribe, eighteen (18) years of age or older, shall have the
right to vote. As enrolled members, Plaintiffs have the right to vote in the 2016
elections.

16 *Id.*, at 15, 20 (emphasis, alterations in original; citations omitted).²

17 14. By scheduling Order on February 12, 2016, Chief Judge Alexander described the
18 “current situation regarding the 2016 Tribal Council elections” as “serious and urgent.”

19 15. On February 22, 2016, Tribal Councilperson Defendants, by and through then
20 Nooksack Tribal Attorney Ray Dodge, “announced for the first time that an additional 40 voters
21 would be singled out” for voter disenfranchisement, meaning not merely the Nooksack 306

² The Trial Court also remarked: “The weak thread running through the fabric of Defendants’ arguments, now and
24 throughout the litigation, is the assumption that [the “Nooksack 306”] Plaintiffs are not eligible for enrollment.” *Id.*

1 Plaintiffs. *Belmont v. Kelly*, No. 2013-CI-CL-007, Order Denying Defendants' Motion for
2 Reconsideration of Order on Preliminary Injunction (Nooksack Tr. Ct. Feb. 29, 2016), at 10.

3 16. On February 29, 2016, Chief Judge Alexander denied Tribal Councilperson
4 Defendants' request for reconsideration of her January 26, 2016 Order. Reiterating the Trial
5 Court's prior ruling that, "Unequivocally, Plaintiffs are enrolled members of the Nooksack
6 Indian Tribe and, pursuant to Nooksack Constitution," the Court further found: "all enrolled
7 members of the Nooksack Tribe – including Plaintiffs and Defendants, including those old
8 enough to vote and those not – have a 'strong interest in fair and timely elections.'" *Id.* (quoting
9 Order Denying Defendants' Motion for Preliminary Injunction, *supra*, at 20-21) (emphasis in
10 original).

11 17. On March 22, 2016, the Nooksack Court of Appeals, operated by and through the
12 Northwest Intertribal Court System (NICS), denied Defendants' request for interlocutory review
13 of Chief Judge Alexander's January 26, 2016 and February 29, 2016 Orders. *Belmont v. Kelly*,
14 No. 2013-CI-APL-001, Order Denying Permission for Interlocutory Appeal, at 1 (Nooksack Ct.
15 App. Mar 22, 2016). The Appeals Court noted: "Although Respondents may eventually face
16 disenrollment proceedings—they are currently enrolled members. Neither the Constitution nor
17 the Nooksack election code prohibits an enrolled member from voting even where the member is
18 the target of such disenrollment proceedings." *Id.*, at 1.

19 18. By February 20, 2016 and March 19, 2016, respectively, Defendants refused to
20 call the Primary Election and General Election for Defendants Rick D. George, Agripina Smith,
21 Katherine Canete and Agripina "Lona" Johnson's then open Tribal Council seats.

22 19. On or about March 24, 2016, Defendants Rick D. George, Agripina Smith,
23 Katherine Canete and Agripina "Lona" Johnson's Tribal Council seats "expired" and left
24 "vacant." *See also Appendix A* (Letter from Lawrence Roberts, Principal Deputy Assistant

1 Secretary – Indian Affairs, U.S. Department of the Interior to Robert Kelly, Jr., Nooksack Tribal
2 Chairman (Oct. 17, 2016) (“Roberts Letter”). Holdover Tribal Councilperson Defendants have
3 not been able to take, and thus have not taken, *any* lawful action since March 24, 2016, “because
4 of the lack of a quorum.” *Id.* (citing Nooksack Bylaws, Art. II § 4).

5 20. On March 28, 2016, Holdover Tribal Councilperson Defendants fired Chief
6 Justice Alexander “as [she] was preparing a final draft of [her] ruling” to compel the election for
7 Defendants Rick D. George, Agripina Smith, Katherine Canete and Agripina “Lona” Johnson’s
8 now expired and vacant Tribal Council seats. Memorandum from Hon. Susan M. Alexander,
9 former Nooksack Tribal Court Chief Judge, to Samantha Wohlfeil, Reporter, Bellingham Herald
10 (Apr. 21, 2016).³

11 21. Meanwhile, in March 2016, Holdover Tribal Council Defendants served Tribal
12 Councilwoman Carmen Tageant was served with a “Notice of Valid Petition,” charging her with
13 “treason” for voting against some “ratification” of the Nooksack Constitution that was amended
14 by a vote of Nooksack members in 2014. Councilwoman Tageant never received a copy of the
15 actual recall petition or any signatures affixed thereto, despite repeated requests for it to
16 Holdover Tribal Council Defendants, in violation of Nooksack Constitution, Article VI, Section
17 1 and NTC §60.02.010. Defendants failed to provide voting materials to all enrolled Nooksack
18 members, and purportedly recalled Councilwoman Tageant on or about April 22, 2016. The
19 U.S. Department of the Interior has since rejected the “alleged” recall election of Councilwoman
20 Tageant. Roberts Letter, n.1

21 22. All the while, disenrollment of the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs has been stayed and
22 enjoined pursuant to *multiple* Orders from the Nooksack Tribal Judiciary since February 26,

1 2015. *Belmont v. Kelly*, Court No. 2014-CI-CL-007, Order (Nooksack Tr. Ct. Feb. 26, 2015);
2 *Belmont v. Kelly*, No. 2013-CI-APL-001, Order Regarding the Petition for Writ of Mandamus
3 Nooksack Ct. App. June 18, 2016), at 3; Order Denying Motion To Expand Jurisdiction, at 1
4 (Nooksack Ct. App. Aug. 29, 2016); Order Granting Requests to Join April 15, 2016 Motion and
5 Be Subject to June 28, 2016 Order (Nooksack Ct. App. Sept. 21, 2016); Second Amended Order
6 Granting Requests to Join April 15, 2016 Motion and Be Subject to June 28, 2016 Order
7 (Nooksack Ct. App. Sept. 22, 2016); *see also Roberts v. Kelly*, No. 2013-CI-CL-003 Order
8 Enjoining Disenrollment Proceedings (Nooksack Tr. Ct. Mar. 31, 2014) (“Disenrollment
9 Injunction Orders”).

10 23. Each of the Disenrollment Injunction Orders remain binding upon Tribal Council
11 Defendants. Roberts Letter, at 1 (“Since NICS was authorized by a quorum of the Council to
12 adjudicate matters prior to March 24, 2015, we will continue to recognize judicial decisions
13 issued by the NICS.”).

14 24. On October 7, 2016, Holdover Tribal Council Defendants amended Title 62 to
15 provide:

16 **62.04.020 Eligible Voter.**

17 Each enrolled member of the Nooksack Indian Tribe, who is not currently subject to
18 disenrollment proceedings or relinquishment, who is eighteen (18) years of age or over, and who
19 currently resides in Whatcom County, shall have the right to vote. The voter must be at least age
eighteen (18) on the scheduled election day in order to vote.

20 Holdover Tribal Council Defendants’ amendment violates, *inter alia*, Nooksack Constitution,
21 Article VI, Section 1; the Nooksack Trial Court’s Order Denying Defendants’ Motion for
22 Preliminary Injunction and Order Denying Defendants’ Motion for Reconsideration of Order on
23 Preliminary Injunction in *Belmont*; and the Nooksack Appeals Court’s Order Denying
24 Permission for Interlocutory Appeal in *Belmont* (“Nooksack Voting Rights Laws”).

1 25. Holdover Tribal Council Defendants' amendment of NTC §62.04.020 also runs
2 afoul of the Roberts Letter, by which the U.S. Department of the Interior made clear that
3 Nooksack elections must be "open to 'all enrolled members of the Nooksack Tribe, eighteen
4 years of age or over' regardless of county residency.'" (quoting Nooksack Const., Art. VI § 1;
5 citing *Belmont v. Kelly*, No. 2013-CI-CL-007, Order Denying Defendants' Motion for
6 Preliminary Injunction).

7 26. Holdover Tribal Council Defendants also amended Title 62 on October 7, 2016,
8 to disqualify any enrolled Nooksack member who does not reside in Whatcom County, or is
9 subject to disenrollment proceedings, from running for Tribal Council office, in violation of
10 Article IV, Sections 2 and 3 of the Nooksack Constitution. NTC § 62.04.030(A) (defining
11 "Qualified Candidate" vis-à-vis "Eligible Voter" per NTC § 62.04.020).

12 27. More generally, Holdover Tribal Council Defendants seek to gerrymander any
13 Tribal Council election by allowing Nooksack members who live in Whatcom County easier
14 access to voting by mail, than those who live beyond Whatcom County. *See* NTC § 62.06.030.

15 28. In October 2016, notwithstanding the Disenrollment Injunction Orders, Holdover
16 Tribal Council Defendants commenced a Referendum Election to disenroll the Nooksack 306
17 Plaintiffs "immediately for their failure to provide proper evidence establishing their claim for
18 enrollment[.]" **Appendix B.** The "Official Referendum Election Ballot" admits that the Tribal
19 Court "entered an order on February 26, 2015, requiring the parties to maintain the 'status quo'
20 pending disposition of the IBIA proceedings." *See Belmont v. Kelly*, Court No. 2014-CI-CL-
21 007, Order (Nooksack Tr. Ct. Feb. 26, 2015). The disenrollment Referendum Election is
22 scheduled to occur on November 4, 2016, in violation of the various Nooksack Voting Rights
23 Laws and the Roberts Letter.

1 29. As of today, both those Plaintiffs and other enrolled Nooksack members who do
2 not reside in Whatcom County, and the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs who are subject to disenrollment
3 proceedings, have not received disenrollment Referendum Election voting materials, also in
4 violation of the various Nooksack Voting Rights Laws and the Roberts Letter.

5 30. On October 17, 2016, also notwithstanding the Disenrollment Injunction Orders,
6 Holdover Tribal Council Defendants have issued Notices of Involuntary Disenrollment to the
7 Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs, scheduling telephonic “meetings” for each and every one of them at 10
8 a.m. on November 10, 2016, despite Nooksack Tribal Council Resolution No. 13-11 and Title 63
9 still requiring final approval by the Secretary of U.S. Department of the Interior. **Appendix C;**
10 *Roberts v. Kelly*, No. 2013-CI-CL-003, Order Enjoining Disenrollment Proceedings; *Belmont v.*
11 *Kelly*, Court No. 2014-CI-CL-007, Order. Holdover Tribal Council Defendants’ issuance of
12 those notices and scheduling of those meetings violates the various Disenrollment Injunction
13 Orders and the Roberts Letter.

14 31. On or around October 21, 2016, Defendants issued an “Official Notice” of
15 Nooksack Tribal Council Election, for Defendants Rick D. George, Agripina Smith, Katherine
16 Canete and Agripina “Lona” Johnson’s now expired and vacant Tribal Council seats. **Appendix**
17 **D.** Holdover Tribal Council Defendants appointed Katherine Canete’s twin sister, Katrice
18 Romero to serve as Election Superintendent. Defendants purport to notice a December 17, 2016
19 Primary Election and January 21, 2017 General Election for those four seats, by which time
20 Holdover Tribal Council Defendants propose to have disenrolled the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs via
21 the November 4, 2016 disenrollment Referendum Election and/or November 10, 2016 mass
22 telephonic disenrollment meeting.

23 32. Defendants’ issuance of the “Official Notice” and scheduling of December 17,
24 2016 Primary Election and January 21, 2017 General Election, to the exclusion of Plaintiffs and

1 other enrolled Nooksack members who do not reside in Whatcom County and the Nooksack 306
2 Plaintiffs, further violates the various Nooksack Voting Rights Laws and the Roberts Letter.

3 **V. FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION**
4 **(Injunction/Writ of Mandamus – Violations of Articles III and IV of the Nooksack**
5 **Constitution)**

6 33. Plaintiffs incorporate and reallege the foregoing allegations.

7 34. Plaintiffs are not requesting affirmative action to the extent that such relief cannot
8 be granted by a writ of mandamus. *Lomeli*, No. 2013-CI-APL-002, at 12 (this Court possesses a
9 “constitutional grant of jurisdiction to authorize the issuance of a writ of mandamus to compel
10 Tribal Council officers to perform constitutionally required non-discretionary duties.”).

11 35. The Nooksack Constitution and Election Ordinance required the February 20,
12 2016 Primary Election and March 19, 2016 General Election for Defendants Rick D. George,
13 Agripina Smith, Katherine Canete and Agripina “Lona” Johnson’s four open seats. Const., Art.
14 III, §§ 3-4; Nooksack Tribal Code §§ 62.02.020-030.

15 36. Defendants unconstitutionally and illegally failed to call or commence the
16 election for Defendants Rick D. George, Agripina Smith, Katherine Canete and Agripina “Lona”
17 Johnson’s expired and vacant Tribal Council seats within 90 days prior to the expiration of the
18 terms of those Defendants’ Tribal Council offices.

19 37. Defendants have also attempted to unconstitutionally and illegally schedule a
20 December 17, 2016, Primary Election and January 21, 2017, General Election for Defendants
21 Rick D. George, Agripina Smith, Katherine Canete and Agripina “Lona” Johnson’s expired and
22 vacant seats.

23 38. Defendants have also attempted to unconstitutionally and illegally disqualify any
24 enrolled Nooksack member who does not reside in Whatcom County, or is subject to
25 disenrollment proceedings, from running for Tribal Council office, particularly for Defendants

1 Rick D. George, Agripina Smith, Katherine Canete and Agripina "Lona" Johnson's expired and
2 vacant seats; and otherwise gerrymander any Tribal Council election by allowing Nooksack
3 members who live in Whatcom County easier access to voting by mail, than those who live
4 beyond Whatcom County.

5 39. Defendants have also attempted to unconstitutionally and illegally schedule a
6 disenrollment Referendum Election for November 4, 2016, and telephonic disenrollment
7 "meetings" for the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs for 10 AM on November 10, 2016.

8 40. Defendants have also attempted to unconstitutionally and illegally recall
9 Councilwoman Carmen Tageant from her Tribal Council seat.

10 41. Plaintiffs have clear legal or equitable rights and a well-grounded fear of
11 immediate invasion of those rights. The relative equities of the parties favor granting injunctive
12 relief. Defendants have acted and are continuing to act in excess of their constitutional authority
13 in this matter. If not enjoined by order of the Court, Defendants will continue to act
14 unconstitutionally, and Plaintiffs will suffer irreparable injury. Plaintiffs do not have a plain,
15 speedy, and adequate remedy in the ordinary course of law.

16 42. An actual controversy exists between the parties concerning the issues identified
17 above.

18 43. A judicial determination resolving this actual controversy is necessary and
19 appropriate at this time.

20 **VI. SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION**
21 **(Injunction/Writ of Mandamus – Violations of Article IX of the Nooksack Constitution)**

22 44. Plaintiffs incorporate and reallege the foregoing allegations.

23 45. Nooksack Tribal Code Ch. 62, particularly §§ 62.04.020 and 62.04.030(A),
24 violates Article IX of the Nooksack Constitution.

1 46. Defendants' policy to "cancel" the February 20, 2016 Primary Election and
2 March 19, 2016 General Election for Defendants Rick D. George, Agripina Smith, Katherine
3 Canete and Agripina "Lona" Johnson's expired and vacant seats and to "postpone" any election
4 for those seats until after disenrollment proceedings against the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs finally
5 conclude—whether through the unconstitutional and illegal disenrollment Referendum Election
6 on November 4, 2016, or the unconstitutional and illegal telephonic disenrollment "meetings" on
7 November 10, 2016—also violates Article IX of the Nooksack Constitution.

8 47. The right to equal protection protected by Article IX of the Nooksack Constitution
9 directs that all persons similarly situated should be treated alike. Defendants' policy, directly
10 targeted at Plaintiffs who do not reside in Whatcom County and the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs,
11 violates this provision of the Nooksack Constitution.

12 48. Where a governmental policy substantially burdens fundamental rights, such as
13 the right to vote, "strict scrutiny applies" and the government's act or omission will be enjoined
14 unless it "can show that the statute is narrowly drawn to serve a compelling state interest."
15 *Green v. City of Tucson*, 340 F.3d 891, 896 (9th Cir. 2003) (citing *Kramer v. Union Free Sch.*
16 *Dist. No. 15*, 395 U.S. 621, 627-28 (1969)); *Belmont v. Kelly*, No. 2013-CI-CL-007, Order
17 Denying Defendants' Motion for Preliminary Injunction, at 14-15.

18 49. Defendants acts and policy is intended to deny Plaintiffs who do not reside in
19 Whatcom County, and the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs, the right to vote. This does not pass equal
20 protection muster because it does not pass the strict scrutiny standard applicable to Plaintiffs'
21 right to vote. *Id.* Indeed, it would not even pass the rational basis standard. *Id.*

22 50. Preventing Plaintiffs who do not reside in Whatcom County, or the Nooksack 306
23 Plaintiffs, from voting is not a compelling state interest. All Plaintiffs are enrolled Nooksacks.
24 No Plaintiffs have been disenrolled. All Plaintiffs are entitled to vote, regardless of where they

1 reside. Defendants must be enjoined from acting in furtherance of any government policy that
2 targets Plaintiffs who do not reside in Whatcom County, or the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs, and
3 unlawfully restricts their constitutional right to vote.

4 51. Plaintiffs who do not reside in Whatcom County, and the Nooksack 306 Plaintiffs,
5 have clear legal or equitable rights and a well-grounded fear of immediate invasion of those
6 rights. The relative equities of the parties favor granting injunctive relief. Defendants have
7 acted and are continuing to act in excess of their constitutional authority in this matter. If not
8 enjoined by order of the Court, Defendants will continue to act unconstitutionally, and Plaintiffs
9 will suffer irreparable injury. Plaintiffs do not have a plain, speedy, and adequate remedy in the
10 ordinary course of law.

11 52. An actual controversy exists between the parties concerning the issues identified
12 above.

13 53. A judicial determination resolving this actual controversy is necessary and
14 appropriate at this time.

15 **VII. RELIEF REQUESTED**

16 WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs pray for relief as follows:

- 17 A. For injunctive relief;
18 B. For declaratory judgment;
19 C. For writ of mandamus;
20 D. For attorneys' fees and costs; and
21 E. For such other relief as the Tribal Court may deem just and equitable.

22 Plaintiffs reserve the right to further amend their Complaint.

Dear Chairman Kelly:

As you know, the Nooksack Tribal Council (Council) lacks a quorum to conduct tribal business as required by the Nooksack Tribe's (Tribe) Constitution and Bylaws. Four Council members' terms expired in March 2016, and an election was never held to fill their seats. The Council currently consists of four members.¹ The Nooksack constitution and bylaws provide:

"At any special or regular meeting of the tribal council, five (5) members present shall constitute a quorum and the tribal council may proceed to transact any business that may come before it."²

Accordingly, pursuant to the plain language of the Tribe's Constitution and Bylaws, the Council must have five duly elected officers to take any official action.

In rare situations where a tribal council does not maintain a quorum to take action pursuant to the Tribe's Constitution, the Department of the Interior (Department) does not recognize actions taken by the Tribe. This is one of those exceedingly rare situations. Accordingly, I am writing to inform you and the remaining Council members that the Department will only recognize those actions taken by the Council prior to March 24, 2016, when a quorum existed, and will not recognize any actions taken since that time because of the lack of a quorum.

We will not recognize any actions until duly elected officials are seated in accordance with the Tribe's Constitution and Bylaws. This includes recent actions by you and two Council members to enjoin the authority of the Northwest Intertribal Court System (NICS). Since the NICS was authorized by a quorum of the Council to adjudicate matters prior to March 24, 2016, we will continue to recognize judicial decisions issued by the NICS.

I want to be clear that the Department is not interpreting the Tribe's Constitution or interfering in internal tribal matters. The Department fully respects tribal sovereignty and tribal law. Rather, we are underscoring that pursuant to our government-to-government relationship between the United States and the Nooksack Tribe, we will only recognize action taken in accordance with the Tribe's Constitution and Bylaws.

¹ Another Council member was allegedly recalled via an election in April.

² Nooksack Bylaws Article II Section 4.

Under Federal law, the United States has a duty to ensure that tribal trust funds, Federal funds for the benefit of the Tribe, and our day-to-day government-to-government relationship is with a full quorum of the Council as plainly stated in the Tribe's Constitution and Bylaws. As such, the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) will examine any self-determination contracts or funding agreements it has with the Tribe to ensure the Tribe's compliance with all contract provisions. In the event of non-compliance, BIA will take action to reassume the particular Federal services, in whole or in part, and provide direct services to currently enrolled tribal members.

The BIA stands ready to provide technical assistance and support to the Tribe to carry out elections open to "all enrolled members of the Nooksack Tribe, eighteen years of age or over" regardless of county residency, to vote to fill the vacant Council seats.³ Please be advised that elections inconsistent with Nooksack law will not be recognized by the Department. BACKGROUND:

The Nooksack Indian Tribe Referendum Committee circulated a referendum petition asking the above question. The Referendum Petition was brought forward with more than the 1/3 required number of eligible voters.

The Tribal Council initiated disenrollment proceedings against nearly 300 individuals for failure to provide proper evidence establishing their original claims for enrollment. In 2014, Tribal Council passed a resolution that approved an amended Title 63 to include court-approved disenrollment proceeding rules. Shortly following passage of the resolution, the Tribal Council forwarded Title 63 to the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Department of Interior, Northwest Regional Office, and obtained approval for the ordinance in late 2014. The opponents of the ordinance then appealed the approval of the ordinance to the IBIA. The Tribal Court then entered an order on February 26, 2015 requiring the parties to maintain the "status quo" pending disposition of the IBIA proceedings. The IBIA has yet to decide the case.

If the referendum passes with the requisite number of "Yes" votes it will be binding on the Tribal Council and Tribal Council shall immediately recommence disenrollment proceedings and the referendum will supersede the Tribal Council decision to seek external approval of Title 63 above that already received.

You previously received a Notice of Basis for Disenrollment with accompanying attachments, which outlines the evidence relied upon for these actions. Failure to abide by applicable law and/or rules, or failure to attend your meeting at the designated date and time, may result in your disenrollment from the Nooksack Indian Tribe.
