
On November 18, 2016, and December 13, 2016, the Indian Health Service sent you letters regarding the need for the Nooksack Indian Tribe (Tribe) to continue to provide health care services for the enrolled members the Tribe was disenrolling. As indicated in the December 13, 2016, it appears that subsequent actions to disenroll these members by the Nooksack Tribal Council lacked a sufficient quorum and were done in violation of the Tribe's own Constitution and bylaws. The Tribal Council's lack of a quorum has also interfered with the Agency's ability to negotiate and enter into a new annual funding agreement under the Tribe's Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act (ISDEAA) contract.

In response to the Nooksack Tribe's recent actions, and the Tribe's failure to respond to the Agency's requests in the letters referenced above, the Contracting Officer, Ms. Imogene Ingawanup, has issued the enclosed notice to the Tribe. Please note the timeframe that a response is required in order to not place the Tribe's current contract in jeopardy.

I am ready to meet with the Tribal Council to further understand the position of the Nooksack Tribe and hopefully resolve this matter amicably.
