Plaintiffs-Appellants have filed (1) an "expedited" injunction pending appeal seeking to restore a preliminary injunction against Defendants-Appellees, and (2) an emergency motion for injunction pending appeal.

We require a response to the injunction motions from Defendants-Appellees. The response shall be filed by 9:00 a.m., MST on March 10, 2017. We also enter a temporary injunction enjoining the Defendants-Appellees from taking any action that threatens, revokes, conditions, modifies, fines, or otherwise punishes or takes enforcement action
