Defendant Nooksack Tribal Court Chief Judge Raymond G. Dodge, Jr. ("Judge Dodge") hereby joins in the Kelly Defendants' Motion for Indicative Ruling Regarding Dismissal (Dkt. #144) and further asks that the Court to issue an order to dismiss all claims as to Judge Dodge for

This Court should relinquish jurisdiction and dismiss the RICO claims against Judge Dodge. In response to the Kelly Defendants' Motion to Dismiss earlier in this case, this Court found that, because deference was owed to the DOI decisions, it had jurisdiction "in the interim period where the tribal leadership is considered inadequate by the DOI." Dkt. # 62 at 10-11. The Court noted, however, that its jurisdiction was "not permanent or inflexible" and that "if the DOI

and BIA recognize tribal leadership after new elections, this Court will no longer have
jurisdiction and the issues will be resolved internally." *Id.* As provided in the Joint Status Report
filed March 13, 2018 (Dkt. # 141), DOI has now recognized the current Nooksack Tribal
Council. As a result, this Court no longer has jurisdiction over any aspect of this RICO dispute
as to all defendants, including the claims as to Judge Dodge. Because the Court currently
exercises jurisdiction as to the claims against Judge Dodge which are not subject to appeal, the
Court may proceed to dismiss the claims against Judge Dodge at any time.

For the foregoing reasons, Judge Dodge respectfully joins in the Kelley Defendants' motion for indicative order and requests that the Court dismiss Plaintiffs' claims against Kelly Judge Dodge.
