THE FLORIDA BAR'S RESPONSE TO NOTICE OF BANKRUPTCY

COMES NOW, The Florida Bar, by and through its undersigned counsel and files its Response to Respondent's Notice of Bankruptcy, and states:

- 1. On February 1, 2018, Respondent filed his Notice of Bankruptcy, and indicated that pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §362, the Florida Bar proceedings pending against Respondent are stayed. Respondent's assertion is without merit.
- 2. Disciplinary proceedings are exempted from the automatic stay provisions of the Bankruptcy Code by the police and regulatory power exception. 11 U.S.C. § 362 (b)(4); *In re McAtee*, 162 B.R. 574 (Fla. N.D. 1993). See also, Risker v. Comm'n For Lawyer Discipline, 94 S.W.3d 625 (Tex. App. 2002)(Attorney disciplinary proceeding fell under police and regulatory power exception in bankruptcy code, and therefore was not subject to automatic stay when attorney filed for bankruptcy. The disciplinary proceeding was for purpose of

enforcing the state Supreme Court's regulatory power over attorneys licensed by state); and *In re Friedman & Shapiro*, *P.C.*, 185 B.R. 143 (S.D.N.Y. 1995)(Disciplinary actions to regulate the professional conduct of attorneys falls squarely into the exception to the automatic stay.).

3. Similarly, Respondent will not be permitted to discharge in bankruptcy any costs imposed in the disciplinary case. *See ie., In re Feingold*, 730 F.3d 1268 (11th Cir. 2013)(Costs and expenses assessed against an attorney in disciplinary proceedings are in the nature of a "fine, penalty or forfeiture," payable to and for the benefit of a "governmental unit," which an attorney cannot discharge when he later files for bankruptcy.)
