diplomatically and firmly negotiates optimum revenue return for the Navajo Nation; improves opinion or perception of the Navajo Nation Taxation program; coordinates with the Department of Justice on appeals. Serves as legal advisor for Tax Commission staff; answers questions regarding application of taxes to situations; provides advisce and drafts written opinions; answers and explains details on how taxes are applied; receives comments from taxpayers on the Nations taxes; issues private and public rulings regarding application of NN taxes to a particular activity, when taxpayers file request; assist in the collection of unpaid taxes.
