The Morongo Band of Mission Indians, located near Banning, California is seeking a Tribal Attorney to provide counsel and legal advice and representation on a broad range of matters affecting the Morongo Tribal Government and its various departments, subject to the direction and oversight of the In-House Counsel. This is an exempt position.

BASIC DUTIES: Under the direction of the In House Counsel, the Tribal Attorney shall represent the interests of the Morongo Tribe, Morongo Tribal Government, Morongo Tribal Administration, and Morongo Tribal programs, in matters such as construction, employment law and transactional matters and economic development.

EXPERIENCE & EDUCATION: Admitted to practice law and in good standing with the California Bar. At least six (6) years of legal experience working for an Indian Tribe, or a firm representing Tribal interests, or eight (8) years of legal experience involving Indian law or related areas. Must have an excellent past work record evidenced by favorable references from past employers, a California State Court Judge, a Federal Judge or Magistrate, or at least two attorneys admitted to practice in the state in which they practice. A Juris Doctor Degree from an accredited U.S. law school with an excellent law school academic record and writing samples.
