Duties and Responsibilities

Responsible for assessing client needs, planning care, coordinating and facilitating the plan, evaluating and re-evaluating the actions required to meet the client's health and human services' needs. Assesses domestic violence resources and provides clients and their families with advocacy support, accurate information, potential referral services and proper treatment plans. Acts as the liaison between victims of domestic violence, therapists, physicians, and other health care or social service agencies.

Minimum Qualifications

- Graduate of an accredited college/university with a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work, Counseling or related field
- A minimum of 2 years paid or volunteer experience in a health care facility or community service agency working with a variety of populations (mentally ill, disabled, substance users, etc.)
- Ability to counsel and be an advocate for people who have been victims of domestic violence, including crisis intervention and case management.
- One (2) year experience working with victim advocacy, counseling and services Current license in good standing if applicable
