

Civil Attorney, Tribal Prosecutor's Office

The Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes have an opening for an entry level position in the Tribal Prosecutor's Office. Applicants must be an attorney admitted to practice Law in the State of Montana, if not admitted must become admitted within six (6) months of hire to maintain employment. All applicants are required to submit a Tribal application, copies of relevant transcripts and/or certificates, writing sample, resume and a cover letter to the Tribal Personnel Department, 406.675.2700 ext. 1259 or visit the www.cskt.org website for the application and full vacancy announcement (Mouse-over the banner for Employment, and click the link for Job Openings) . Closing date will be June 13, 2019 @ 5:30 p.m. The successful applicant, if not already employed with the Tribes, must pass a pre-hire drug test and serve a six-month probationary period.

Position Location: Pablo, Montana

Main Responsibilities: The Attorney shall prosecute child protection cases and in other civil cases such as guardianships, mental health commitments, and child support enforcement actions, as needed. Further, the Attorney shall perform duties as assigned by the Prosecutor's Managing Attorney, including: training, grant writing and other duties including representing Tribal interests routinely litigated in Tribal Court and other actions as necessary to carry out Tribal Council assignments to the Prosecutor's Office as well as performing such administrative and other duties assigned by the Managing Attorney of the Prosecutor's Office. In performance of his/her duties under this contract the Attorney shall be subject to the supervision and direction of the Prosecutor's Managing Attorney. Attorney shall act as Prosecuting Attorney for the Tribal Prosecutor's Office specifically prosecuting criminal cases and juvenile youth court adjudications.
