



# Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians

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## 2020 SUMMER LAW INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians, Office of the Attorney General, operates a summer internship program for one or two law students who have completed at least one year of law school in an ABA accredited institution. The Attorney General seeks applicants with an interest in federal Indian law for a ten-week period, beginning approximately June 3 through August 9, 2020.

This internship will offer the opportunity to obtain practical knowledge and experience regarding both tribal and federal Indian law. The selected law student(s) will assist the Attorney General with preparing legal memoranda on a wide-variety of legal matters handled by the office, and researching and drafting Tribal ordinances, policies and resolutions. This position is full-time, working on-reservation. A stipend equivalent to \$1,000 per week will be paid to the selected candidate(s).

- 1) A cover letter;
- 2) A current resume;
- 3) A brief writing sample; and
- 4) A copy of your transcript.

### Eligibility Requirements

In order to be eligible for selection and participation, an applicant must meet the following requirements at the time the internship begins and for the duration of the internship:

- 1) Must be currently enrolled at an ABA accredited law school and submit an official transcript for the 2019-20 academic year prior to the start of the internship.
- 2) Must not currently be subject to any disciplinary action by any institution or entity, including, but not limited to, any education or law enforcement agency.
- 3) Must possess a high level of maturity, the ability to work independently and understand and maintain confidential information.
- 4) Must possess a valid state driver's license, a car and automobile insurance.
- 5) Must sign a services contract and confidentiality, non-disclosure agreement.
