DNA-People’s Legal Services (DNA) is a non-profit law office committed to providing high quality legal services to persons living in poverty on the Navajo, Hopi and Jicarilla Apache Reservations, and in parts of Northern Arizona, Northwest New Mexico, and Southern Utah. DNA is one of the largest Indian legal service organizations in the country. DNA’s main office, as well as DNA’s Fort Defiance branch office, are located in Window Rock Arizona. DNA also has branch offices in Chinle Arizona, Tuba City Arizona, Flagstaff Arizona, on the Hopi BIA judicial compound near Keams Canyon Arizona, and Farmington New Mexico. Our office in Keams Canyon, designated as our Hopi office, provides civil and criminal defense legal services members of the Hopi and to others primarily living on the Hopi Reservation.

DNA serves clients who live in poverty, with the full range of civil legal needs, such as consumer law, domestic violence, guardianships and other family law, landlord/tenant, employment and public benefits cases. We also provide services to indigent criminal defendants, and we serve as the Hopi Tribe Public Defender. DNA staff practice in tribal, state, federal and administrative courts.

DNA’s primary funding source is the Legal Services Corporation. DNA’s 2019 budget is approximately \$4,600,000.

We currently have openings for attorneys in all of our offices.

We also have summer law clerk positions - fellowship funded positions, volunteer positions, or Work-Study positions - in all of our offices.
