



Please take notice that Plaintiff Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes (“CSKT”) respectfully withdraws their pending Motion for Preliminary Injunction. (Docs. 4 and 5). Recently, CSKT sent counsel for Defendant Lori Lundeen a proposal that would allow her to access her property utilizing the access road that is the subject of this litigation during the pendency of these proceedings. *See* Plaintiff’s Brief in Opposition to Lake County’s Brief in Support of Application for Preliminary Injunction, Exhibits. A – C. Because that offer, in conjunction with the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Notice of Trespass (Doc. 1 at 12, paragraph 45) will likely prevent any further encroachment on the Tribal trust parcel at issue, the CSKT no longer believes their request for preliminary injunction is necessary.
