### Motion in Opposition

Your Honor, I, Annette Cadet plaintiff hereby, submits its opposition to Defendant Snoqualmie Casino's Motion to dismiss the Complaint for a civil case Alleging Negligence.

The Snoqualmie Casino has buses going to the Convention Center, Chinatown and Eastgate Transit Center every day from 10 Am to 6 pm to pick up Vulnerable people to bring to the Casino for a fare of \$10 to go and ride back.

On 5-2-18, at 6 pm I got on the Snoqualmie Casino bus in Chinatown with other casino players. I paid \$10. The driver checked my ID and Casino member's card. When I got to the Casino, in front of the bus a casino staff member gave everybody a little card to take the bus back to Seattle. The last was at 11:20 pm I missed it. I had no money left to take taxi. I asked for ride. I talked to security telling I lost all my money and I missed the last bus. Security staff told me I could wait for the next bus in the morning. I was sitting there waiting for the bus. I do not drink or smoke.

" Around 2 Am I was sitting 20 feet away from a

player who pointed at me and security asked to leave ( see Casino video footage camera). I told the security: "I came on the bus. I am waiting for the next bus. I lost all money. I do not have any kind of transportation on my own". Would you ask for a "Courtesy ride" for me to get out. He said no. I asked for the Casino Supervisor. He refused to give me a Courtesy ride instead he called the police

When the police came I asked for a ride to Seattle and I will not come back. I said the Casino transported me here and they refused to help me out. It's 2 AM and I do not know where to start walking in the dark. The front police officer said that he does not care. Seattle is too far to give you ride. They were 3 officers: "~~Daniel T. Satterberg~~ Francisco Zepeda, Kevin Johnson and Geare Davis of Snoqualmie Police Department, King County.

The Snoqualmie Casino staff was standing there in the front main door assisting those 3 men ( police ) degraded me, abused me because I was black, assaulted me and injured my body ( see video camera footage ). I cannot explain the physical, emotional and mental pain I had been through after these inhuman treatments. I was treated as a real criminal.

" I believe I would <sup>not</sup> receive those treatments if I were from another race or even an animal. " I just

need public transportation. I was there because they had told I was okay to wait. After a female player just like me but different color whom I was around 20 feet away from complaint about me, I was asked to leave. I was not drinking, smoking or doing anything illegal. I was just waiting for the bus to get out. To this day I am still living with the pain. It is very hard to think ~~or~~ talk about it. Human rights: We should all be treated the same way.

The player, the Casino staff and the police violated my International human rights: Do not discriminate. Whatever our differences.

- I was sitting there I could see what she was playing 10-20 feet away. I could not hear her words; but I saw her pointed at me to a cashier. I got up and leave the area. A few minutes later security was following me and harrassing me. I said stop, I am a person just like the other player just different color.

The Snoqualmie Casino was my transportation, I paid them my \$10. They had picked me up 26 miles away. I am a female. It is 7 AM Where can I start walk in, the casino is between bushes and highway no side walk. "I do not want to be raped or killed, I told them." "Safety right". You have right no matter where you go.

- The Snoqualmie Casino caused the police to tortured me. They injured my right shoulder, left arm, left knee, ~~hurt~~ <sup>hit</sup> my head causing nose bleed cup lip. One men was kneeling on top of me. (see video cam footage) "No Torture". Nobody has to torture us. (Human Rights)

\* The Snoqualmie Tribe is Immune to Suit. "  
I believe that the Snoqualmie Casino abused  
(of) people and specially vulnerable players because  
of their immunity.

I believe that they should lose their immunity  
right when they fail to respect the people rights  
because even after we lost our money or do not have  
money at all, we still have our human right. They  
abused vulnerable poor people after losing the money.  
They drove their buses 25 miles to pick us up. We  
paid for Transportation. It is not free. They deserve  
some kind of punishment for not being more  
careful about people safety. At 2 AM

The Snoqualmie Casino had failed to protect their  
Indian Tribe Immunity to Suit because they  
provided me with to get to their Casino, I paid  
they took my payment, no reimbursement, and  
asked to leave at 2 AM with no form of transpor-  
tation in the bushes and highways of Snoqual-  
mie. I was heartbreaking because I did not  
want to get raped or killed after I lost all  
my money in the Casino. They should give player  
with member card a courtesy ride and ask  
not to come back; Because they pick them up

I should be able to suit because of the treatment  
I got after they picked me up, I paid them, the time  
2-2:30 AM, their location and a female.  
"Snoqualmie Casino does not care about safety." "
