- 2. Provides legal advice and support to assigned departments for the Tulalip Tribes- mainly natural resources, environmental and land use.
- 3. Drafts and revises Tribal Codes for the Tribal lawmaking body.
- 4. Conducts legal research concerning Tribal, Federal, and State Law.
- 5. Participates in planning, legal advice and strategy sessions with the Board of Directors and government departments.
- 6. Performs other duties as assigned.

# MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Juris Doctor Degree from an accredited law school.
- Member of the Tulalip Tribes Bar (or have the ability to obtain membership within six months of hire).
