The Grand Jury charges:

On or about the 30th day of September, 2022, in the District of South Dakota, the defendant, Dylan Josiah Blue Bird, did forcibly assault, resist, oppose, impede, intimidate, and interfere with Officer Richard Kumley, while Officer Richard Kumley was a law enforcement officer employed by the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, pursuant to a contract of the Tribe with the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, granting authority under 25 U.S.C. § 2804 to perform law enforcement functions, and while Officer Richard Kumley was engaged in the performance of his official duties, and said conduct did involve the use of a dangerous weapon, that is, a vehicle, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 111(a) and 111(b).
