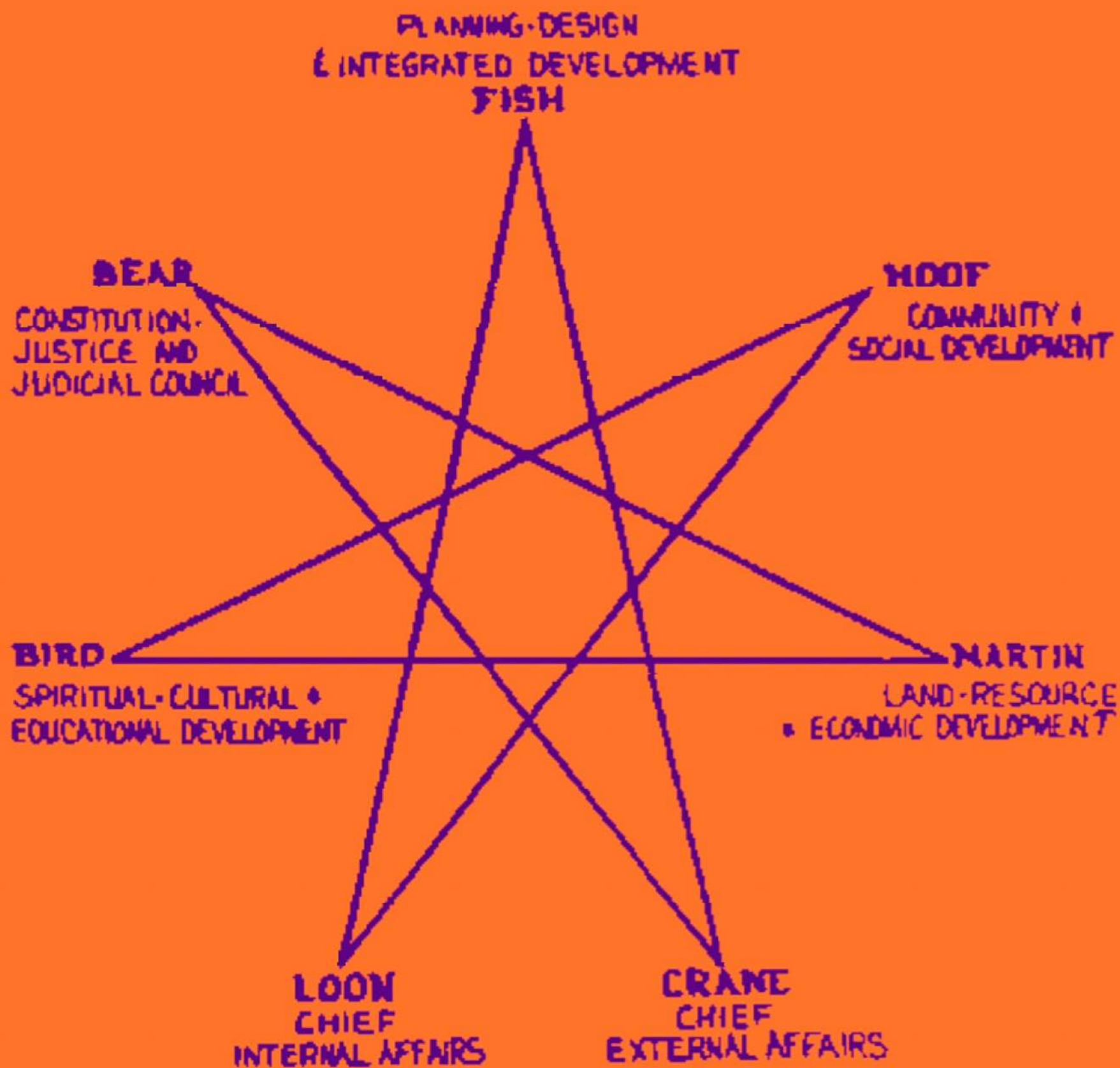
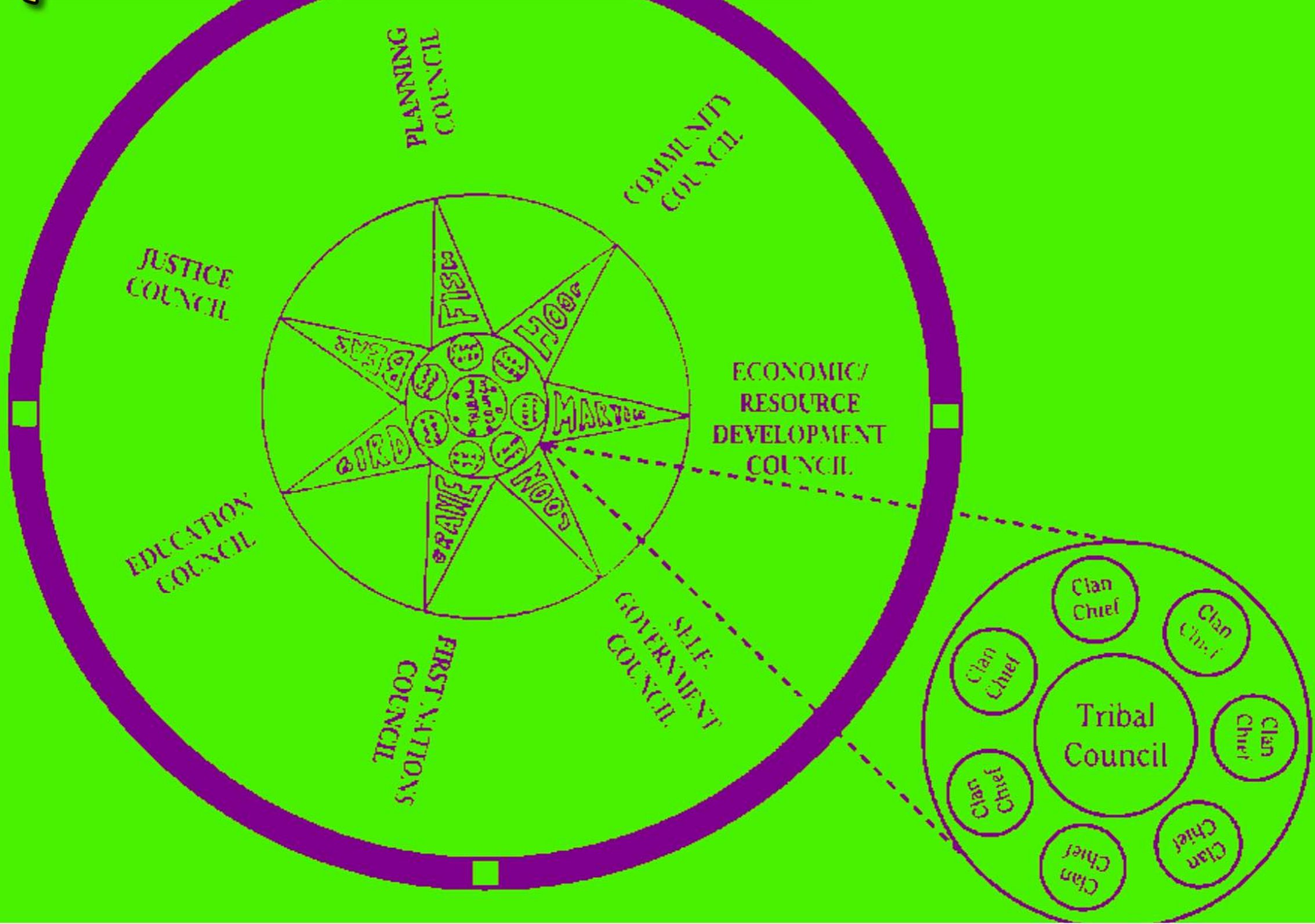

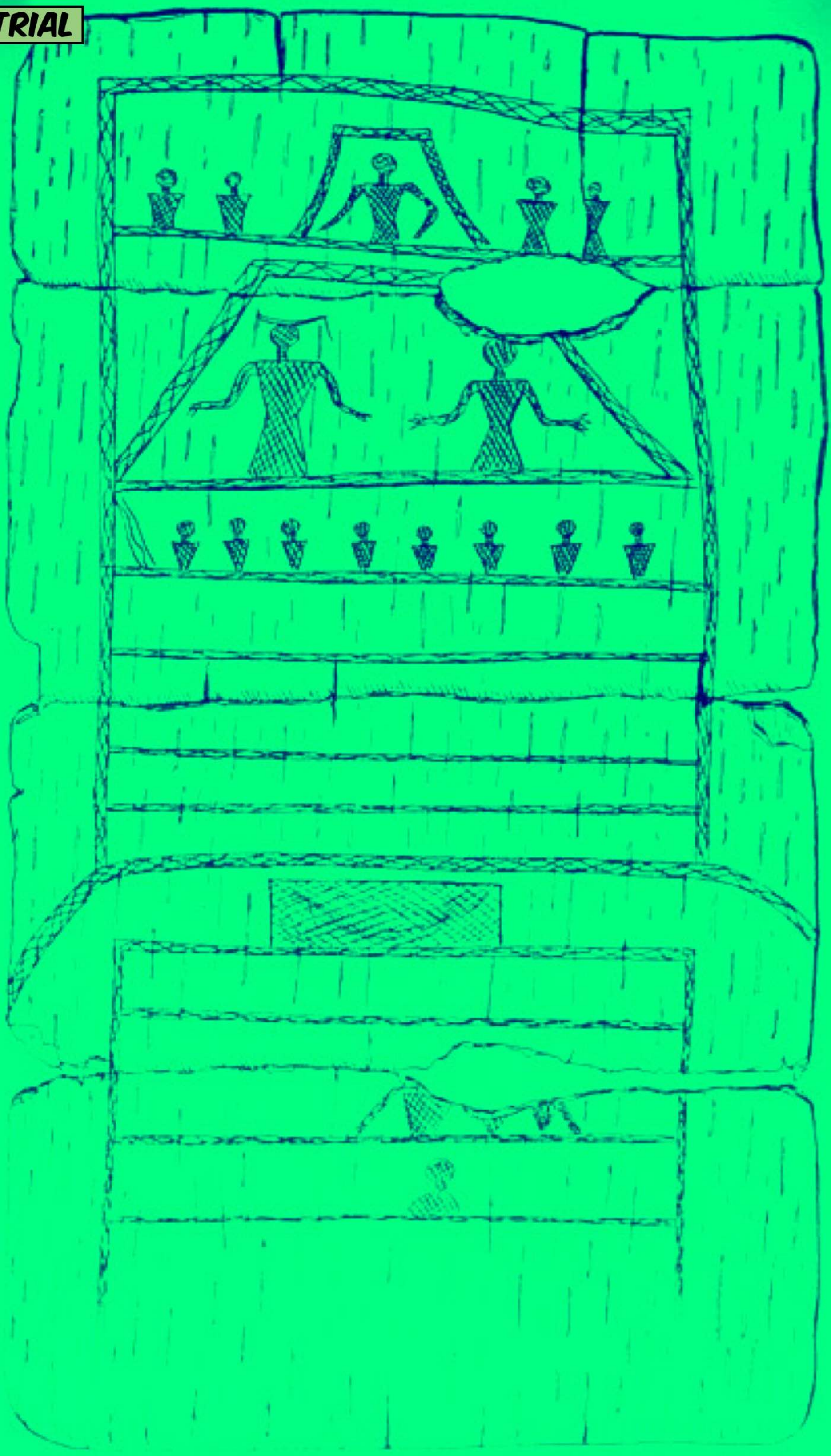


Fig. 30. 50.1.5818b. Birchbark Record accompanying a Medicine Doll.
