Defendant Dale Allan Walker, and DOES 1 to 20, inclusive, was acting in the course and scope of his employment, agency, joint enterprise, and/or independent contractor relationship with Defendant Tule River Tribal Council, and DOES 1 to 20, inclusive, so that Defendants are vicariously liable for the negligence of one another.

Defendant Dale Allan Walker, and DOES 1 to 20, inclusive, negligently operated his motor vehicle by, including but not limited to, failing to keep a proper lookout for other vehicles, including Plaintiff's vehicle. Defendant Dale Allan Walker, and DOES 1 to 20, inclusive, violated the applicable California Vehicle Code Section 21802(a), the driver of any vehicle approaching a stop sign at the entrance to, or within, an intersection shall stop as required by Section 22450. The Driver shall then yield the right-of-way to any vehicles which have approached from another highway, or which are approaching so closely as to constitute an immediate hazard, and shall continue to yield the right-of-way to those vehicles until he or she can proceed with reasonable safety.
