The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT 1

On or about between April 27, 2024, and April 29, 2024, in the Eastern District of Washington, the Defendants, JOSEPH MARTIN PARISIEN and ALAHNA RAE LEA TIMENTWA, did unlawfully and willfully seize, confine, kidnap, and carry away A.P. and, in committing or in furtherance of the commission of the offense, used a means, facility, and instrumentality of interstate and foreign commerce, to wit: a vehicle, public roadways, and a cellular device, and did aid and abet the same, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1201(a)(1), 2.

COUNT 2

On or about between April 27, 2024, and April 29, 2024, in the Eastern District of Washington, within the external boundaries of the Spokane Indian Reservation, in Indian Country, the Defendants, JOSEPH MARTIN PARISIEN, ALAHNA RAE LEA TIMENTWA, and GABRIEL ELAISE TIMENTWA, Indians, did unlawfully and willfully seize, confine, kidnap, and carry away A.P., and did aid and abet the same, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1201(a)(2), 1153, 2.

COUNT 3

On or about April 27, 2024, in the Eastern District of Washington, within the external boundaries of the Spokane Indian Reservation, in Indian Country, the Defendant, JOSEPH MARTIN PARISIEN, an Indian, did intentionally assault A.P., with the intent to commit any felony, to wit: Kidnapping, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1201(a)(1), and Kidnapping in Indian Country, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1201(a)(2), 1153, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 113(a)(2), 1153.

COUNT 4

On or about April 27, 2024, in the Eastern District of Washington, within the external boundaries of the Spokane Indian Reservation, in Indian Country, the

Defendant, JOSEPH MARTIN PARISIEN, an Indian, did intentionally assault A.P., the Defendant's intimate partner and dating partner, resulting in substantial bodily injury to A.P., all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 113(a)(7), 1153.
