

**FINAL JUDGMENT**

**THIS MATTER** comes before the Court on the Stipulation of Dismissal Without Prejudice to Allow Plaintiff to Exhaust Its Remedies in Zuni Tribal Court, filed October 7, 2025 (Doc. 17)(“Stipulated Dismissal”). In the Stipulated Dismissal, the parties agree to dismiss this action without prejudice to allow Plaintiff Rural Community Assistance Corporation to exhaust its remedies in Zuni Tribal Court.
