**ORDER**

**DATE:** September 18, 2025      **JUDGE:** Garrett Eller

This matter comes before the Court on the mandate of the Supreme Court of the Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma, issued July 8, 2025, and on Plaintiff's Motion to Vacate Dismissal and Enter Default Judgment. The Court, having reviewed the Opinion of the Supreme Court, the filings of record, and being fully advised, finds and orders as follows:

**FINDINGS**

1. On October 11, 2023, this Court entered an Order dismissing Plaintiff's Complaint for lack of ripeness, denying Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment, and striking the temporary injunction.
2. On December 18, 2023, this Court entered an Order denying Defendant's Motion for Leave, reinstating the April 13, 2021 Preliminary Injunction, and granting Plaintiff's Motion for Stay Pending Appeal.

3. On July 8, 2025, the Supreme Court of the Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma issued its Opinion reversing this Court's October 11, 2023 Order, holding that:
  - a. This Court has subject matter jurisdiction over the controversy pursuant to Judiciary Act, Title 26, §4.
  - b. The September 2017 Agreement is connected to the November 2016 Agreement and may not be separated for purposes of determining the parties' contractual rights.
  - c. Defendant Monster Technology Group, LLC, failed to plead or otherwise adequately defend and is therefore in default under Title 2, §902.
4. The Supreme Court remanded this case with instructions to:
  - a. Vacate the dismissal of Plaintiff's Complaint; and
  - b. Enter default judgment in favor of Plaintiff, including a permanent injunction against Defendant Monster Technology Group, LLC.

#### **JUDGMENT**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** this Court's prior Order of October 11, 2023, and December 18, 2023, is hereby vacated;

**IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED** Default Judgment is hereby entered in favor of Plaintiff, the Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma, and against Defendant Monster Technology Group, LLC, on all claims

Specifically the Court **DECLARES** and **ORDERS** as follows:

1. It is **DECLARED**, pursuant to Paragraphs 5 and 8 of the September 15, 2017 Asset Agreement, exclusive jurisdiction for any action relating to that Agreement lies in the Courts of the Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma.
2. It is **FURTHER DECLARED** that the Purported Arbitration initiated by Monster Technology Group, LLC before the American Arbitration Association (AAA Case No. 01-20-0019-3927) may not proceed, and that the American Arbitration Association lacks jurisdiction over the Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma.

**IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED** Defendants, their officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them, are hereby permanently enjoined from pursuing arbitration or other proceedings in any other jurisdiction against the Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma under the November 2016 Agreement or otherwise acting in derogation of the Tribe's rights as set forth in the Complaint.
